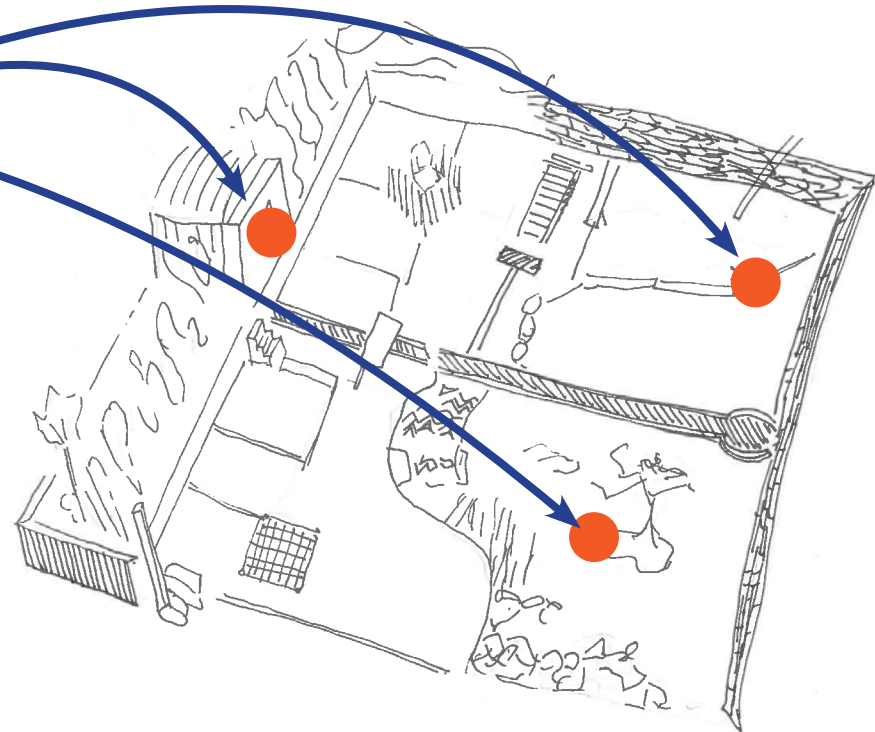

in the garden?

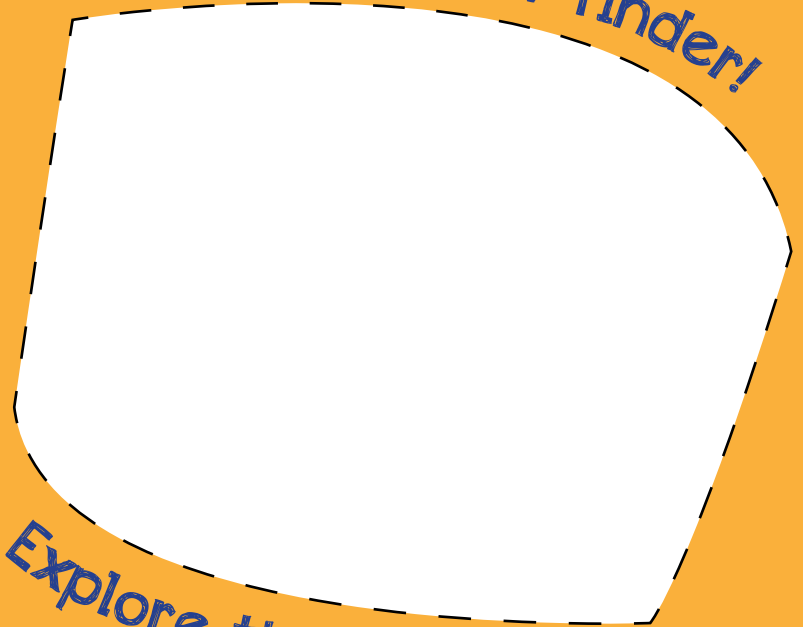

Let's now head to the 3rd floor, to check out Yayoi Kusama's pieces!

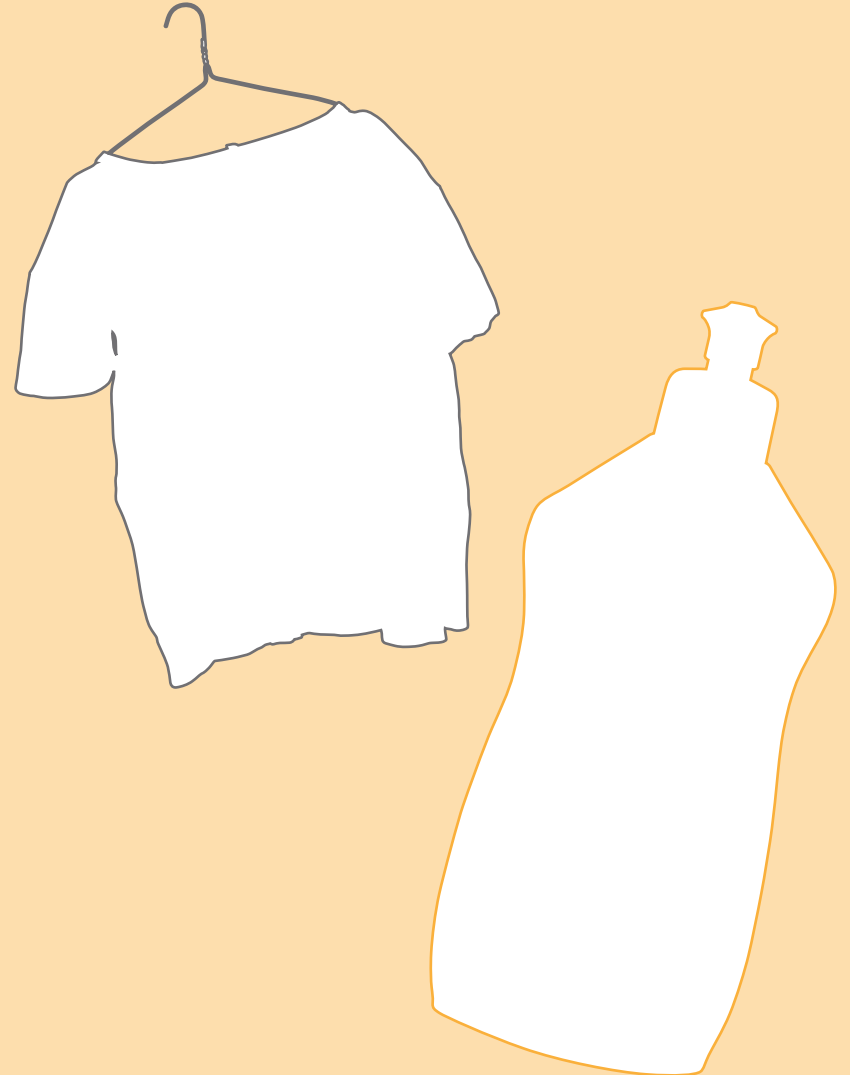
PATTERNS

Head to the second floor to check out the James Turrell art pieces. Are you ready to have fun with light?

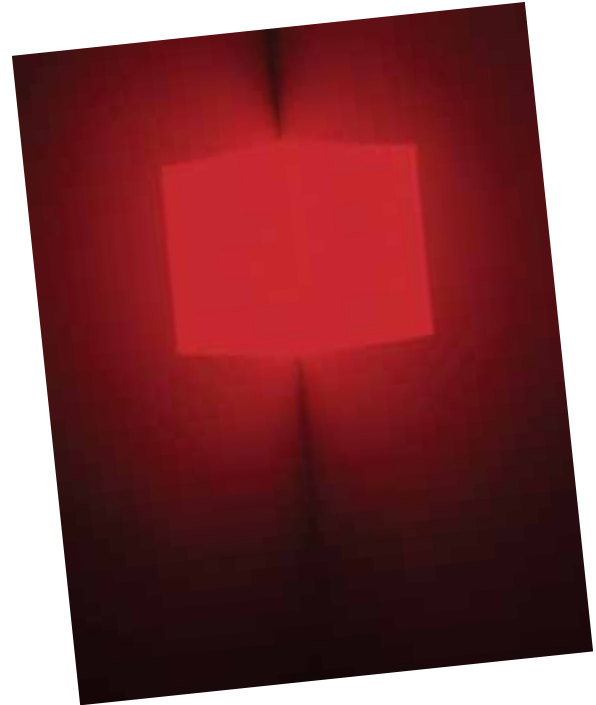
Visit Danaë!
