MATTRESS FACTORY NAMES HAYLEY HALDEMAN INTERIM EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

(PITTSBURGH PA, January 25, 2019) - The Mattress Factory Board of Directors announces the appointment of Hayley Haldeman as Interim Executive Director of the museum. Ms. Haldeman will assume her role as Interim Director on Monday, February 11. She was unanimously appointed by the Board, and she enters her new role with the full support of Judith O'Toole, whose last day as Acting Director will be Thursday, January 31.

Ms. Haldeman has been a litigator with international law firm Jones Day since 2012. She counsels non-profit and tax exempt organizations as part of her pro bono practice and has served on the Mattress Factory Board of Directors since 2014.

I know that she is passionate about the Mattress Factory and dedicated to its success," said Judith O'Toole.
